Focus Rising Feature Vehicle The Mach Edition

The Mach Edition Ford Focus was Introduced in 2002 as a ZTS version 4 door with added features. The first item which comes to mind if you have a MK1 Focus is well it must have Mach headlights, and you would be correct. This is not all the extras this edition came with. For someone that was looking for better sound from a stock audio system this was a step in the right direction. They came with a 6 disk CD changer, upgraded 5x7 door speakers, a dual coil 10 inch subwoofer, with a 460 watt amplifier. As



far as interior appearance upgrades, they came with a silver faced instrument cluster and Orange mesh seats and door cards. The seats and door cards were similar to the SVT



focus. The colors for this edition were CD Sliver, Liquid Grey, and the one only available in the Mach edition Mandarin Copper. There were only 6,000 produced of this special edition. The Mach was a styled ZTS that came with only the Zetec engine.



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
